This year the CJL Board will continue with some changes that began last year. One of those changes is that we will hold All-Star tryouts in August. By doing this we are able to provide a core group of kids that can practice during the winter months and further their skills as well as form a bond as a team. Although making the All-star team in August does not guarantee a spot when the season begins, it does sharpen player's skills. All of the All-star coaches make the final decisions to fill their rosters, and are free to run their team as they see fit. They are volunteers as well so the board gives them a big "Thank You."

We still have the CJL fundraiser cards that can be purchased for \$3 each or 5 cards for \$10. Each player gets 1 card for free when they register. These cards are good for discounts at numerous local businesses and can be used over and over again until March 2010.

We have contracted again with Life Touch Photography for team and individual photos, and with Dan Cheever of MoveUPics to take action photos of your child during tournament games. These photos will be available for purchase and can be viewed on-line at www.moveupics.digitaleventsonline.com. Mr. Cheever will be available before and during the tournaments for parents to take advantage of his services. This website will have a username and password so not just anyone will be able to view them. This is a great way to share action photos of your player with those in the family that are not able to be present at games. Relatives will be able to log on to the site and view/purchase the pictures of their loved ones anywhere! Feel free to stop by and talk in more detail with Dan about this exciting opportunity.

Another improvement will be happening at the complex this spring. The CJL parking lot will receive some much needed improvements in the form of pavement, striped parking slots, and directional traffic control markings. This work will begin in March, and will be completed before our season begins. We would ask that anyone using the facility keep this in mind, and refrain from using the parking lot while improvements are being made.
