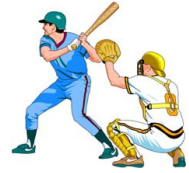
We will once again hold All-Star tryouts in August. By doing this we are able to provide a core group of kids that can practice during the winter months and further their skills as well as form a bond as a team.

We still have the CJL fundraiser cards that can be purchased for \$3 each or 5 cards for \$10. Each player gets 1 card for free when they register. These cards are good for discounts at numerous local businesses and can be used over and over again until March 2011. We have contracted again with Life Touch Photography for team and individual photos and with Dan Cheever of MoveUPics to take action photos of your child during tournament games. The big change affecting CJL Baseball in 2010 is the increase in registration fees. The \$15.00 increase has occurred because of serious budget problems with funding in all areas of City government. In an attempt to continue the great level of service the Parks and Recreation provides us in field maintenance, it became necessary for the City to charge each organization a "field use fee." There will be a \$30.00 charge assessed by the City for each CJL game played and that translates into CJL being required to pay the City a substantial amount in field use fees at the end of our season.

Thank you for registering your child with Cheyenne Junior League. Last year we had over 650 kids participate in baseball and we on the CJL Board are looking forward to an exciting season in 2010.
