

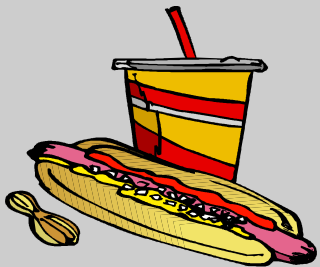

### Sponsorship/Fundraising

Coordinate all mailings of sponsorship solicitations  
Keep track of all sponsorships received and report to the board  
Coordinate all CJL fundraising campaigns

### Registration

Organize registration materials & coordinate times and location of registration  
Schedule the members to work registration  
Update player database and schedule and supervise the development of teams

### Equipment & Uniform

Inventory equipment on hand and conduct check after season ends  
Project equipment needed for the upcoming year and purchase as needed  
Coordinate and schedule equipment checkout  
Solicit bids for uniforms and printing & sort and coordinate uniform distribution

### Tournaments/ Planning

Coordinate all mailings of tournament information  
Plan tournament meetings  
Designate tournament director  
Schedule all tournament workers including field maintenance  
Coordinate tournament umpires

### Scheduling

Develop all league schedules and reschedule as required  
Communicate with Parks & Rec, umpires, teams and Burger Shack

### Pictures

Solicit bids from photography studios  
Present bids to the CJL Board  
Coordinate picture day, make-up dates and coordinate picture distribution

### Field Maintenance

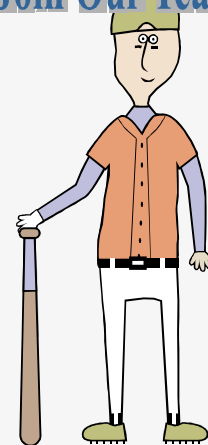
Coordinate with Parks & Rec all needs for the complex for the upcoming year, special improvement projects and work orders.  
Check and advise on field conditions when weather dictates & coordinate field preparation when weather requires  
Prepares Cleanup Day Agendas.

**Rules:** Review rules, make proposed/needed, present changes to the Board for final review and update rule books prior to the start each season
