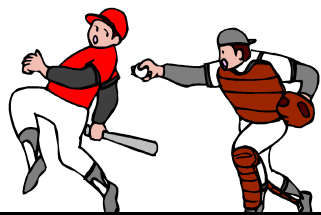
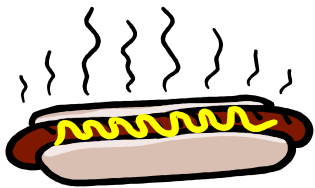

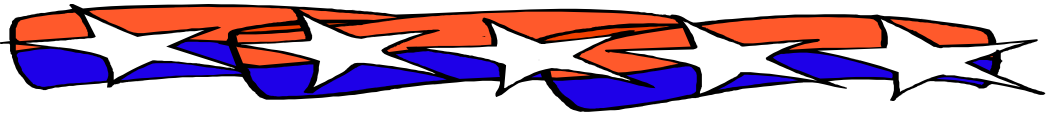

PARKING LOT POLICY

The board would like to remind everyone that the parking lot inside the complex is used for board members, coaches, umpires, concession's personnel and handicapped only. If you do not have a pass to be in the parking lot you need to park in the east or south parking lots.

Do not attempt to persuade the gate person to letting you in or drive in. When there is no one attending the gate if you do not have a pass please do not pull into this coaches parking area. For the safety of everyone we ask that you help us limit the traffic into this area.

Please treat those working the gate with courtesy. Verbal abuse and threats to the gate workers will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the CJL complex and/or loss of park parking privileges.

Please refer to the local ground rules for more information fan, player, official and coach conduct.

Please drive with caution when arriving or departing the CJL complex.

We also ask that fans, parents and coaches drive safely in the parking areas, watch for children walking out from behind parked cars, and please be patient with the other drivers. Let's show good sportsmanship on the field and on the road.
